- 1. It is understood that the teachers are the ultimate authority on this trip. Students are expected to respect their instructions.
- 2. The use of alcohol and/or drugs IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN on the trip. Violation of this rule will immediately result in arrangements for the student to be sent home at the expense of the student's caregiver.
- 3. Smoking is NOT ALLOWED on the trip.
- 4. The common areas of the hostel are the designated socializing areas. Students are not permitted in other students' rooms.
- 5. Curfew will be as follows: in rooms by 10:00, and quiet by 11:00.
- 6. During free time, students must remain in the general area of the hostel. Students are expected to remain in groups of at least three at outdoor common areas such as the fire pit area. Students must inform a teacher if they are going to an outside common area. At all other locations (hotel, Costco, bus stops, Canmore) students must be in a minimum group of 3 people, inform a teacher of where they will be, and arrive at meeting locations at the scheduled time.
- 7. Students are reminded that they are representing Kelvin High School on this trip and should act in accordance with Kelvin's student Code of Behavior which is outlined in the Kelvin High school student agenda book.
